ORDER

In the Letter read as first paper above the Secretary IMG has reported that the retirement age of non-academic staff of IMG was 55. As per memorandum of Association (MOA) of IMG, the Executive Committee shall have the powers to frame Bye-laws regulating rules, terms and conditions of service, pay & allowances and other benefits. Accordingly the 11th meeting of the Executive Committee held on 05.11.1984 was decided to do away the disparity between the academic staff and non-academic staff of IMG with regard to retirement age and to provide for superannuation at 60 years in the case of all employees. The service Rules of IMG were amended accordingly. Hence the Secretary IMG has submitted a proposal to ratify the action of IMG in raising the retirement age to 60 years for IMG staff.

Vide order read as 3rd paper above the Board of Governors of IMG has ratified the action of the Executive Committee in having enhanced the retirement age of IMG staff to 60 years.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to ratify the action of IMG in having enhanced the retirement age of IMG staff to 60 years.
